

Nebraska Head Coach Bill Callahan**On the outcome of the game...**

"I'm very disappointed in the outcome of this game. We came here to play. We dug a hole and couldn't get out, but we did fight back in the second half and put in a good effort, it just wasn't enough."

"We left seven points on the field. It's disheartening to have those chip shots and end up with nothing."

"We want to come out and display the kind of effort that is needed for a championship run, and we didn't have that today. They made the plays that we didn't make."

On what they could have done...

"I felt we would come out and demonstrate the kind of passion we did last week. We didn't have the determination and grit and you have to win on the road to be a championship team."

"You've got to bring your A-game and your defense on the road. We haven't been running on all cylinders collectively. We haven't had all three at the same time."

On ISU's Plays early on...

"It changed the course of the game. They had some great looking wide receivers and we got mismatched on the receiving end. They did a great job doing what they needed to do."

On Nebraska's QB performance....

"He had no turnovers until the last one, which was crucial. The plays were there, just as we had studied them. Dailey worked his feet well and he was at ease. We're just a few plays away from us all sitting here happy."
